Learning Objectives:

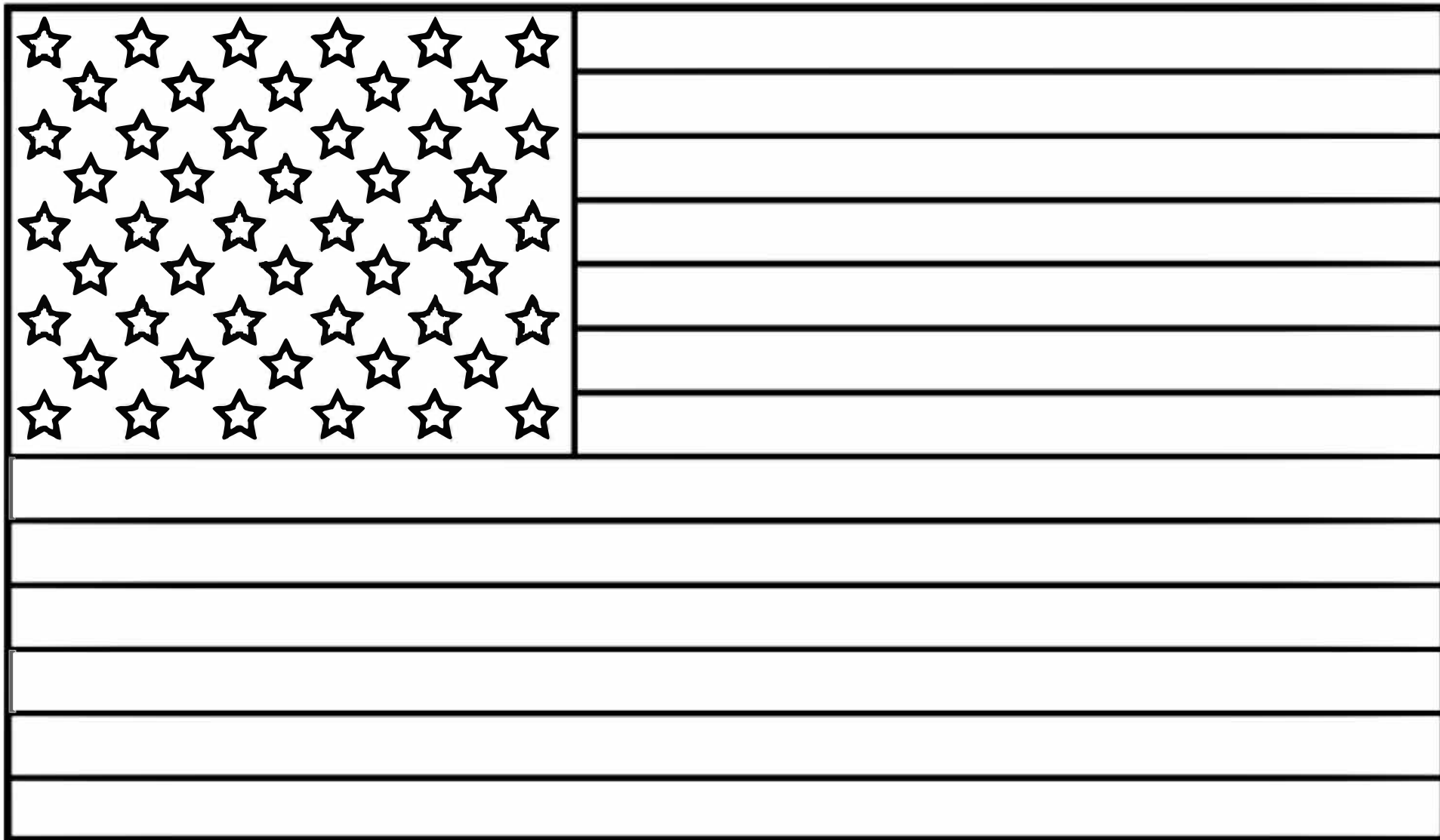
